#### TRIBAL CULTURAL INDICATORS

# Connection to Tribal Traditions and Practices

Description: Knowledge / participation in activities connected to Tribal traditions

Safe / Self-Sufficient: I am knowledgeable, fully engaged in cultural events, ceremonies and gatherings

Stable: I am aware of local cultural events ceremonies and gatherings but I do not always attend

At Risk: I have limited knowledge of cultural events, ceremonies and gatherings and do not participate

In Crisis: I have no knowledge of cultural events, ceremonies and gatherings and do not participate

# Participation in Tribal Activities

Description: Connections to Tribal activities for individuals and families

Safe / Self Sufficient: I have knowledge of Tribal activities and actively participate

Stable: I have knowledge of tribal activities and sometimes participate

At Risk: I have some knowledge or access to Tribal activities but do not participate

In Crisis: I have no knowledge or access to Tribal activities and do not participate

# Knowledge of Family Lineage and Tribal History

Description:

Safe /Self Sufficient: I have much knowledge of my Tribal lineage and family history and believe it is a strength to me

Stable: I have some knowledge of my Tribal lineage and family history and know how this benefits and supports me

At Risk: I have limited knowledge of my Tribal lineage and/or of my family history and am not aware of why it's beneficial to me

In Crisis: I have no knowledge of my Tribal lineage or my family history

## Extended Family Relationship

Description: Identification of available family and support relationships

Safe / Self Sufficient: I always have family / support relationships that can assist

me

Stable: I have at least two reliable family / support members who can consistently support me

At Risk: I have limited family support who may not always be available to assist me

In Crisis: I do not have any immediate or extended family that I am aware of who can assist me

## Participation in Tribal Government Activities

Description: Spiritual education and government issues

Safe / Self Sufficient: I am aware of and have very good knowledge of traditional ceremonial practices, as well as community issues and structure, and I do participate and do my part as a Tribal member

Stable: I am aware of and have some knowledge of traditional ceremonial practices, as well as community issues and structure, and I am aware but do not participate very often

At Risk: I have some knowledge of traditional ceremonial practices and government issues and structure, but I don't participate because I don't see change or really understand it

In Crisis: I have no spiritual education knowledge or knowledge of how to become involved, or I cannot be involved, therefore I do not participate

#### INDIAN CHILD WELFARE ACT

The Indian Child Welfare Act is created to support a cultural perspective and it's program strengths are implemented by ICWA workers to build protective factors for children and families

Knowledge of the Indian Child Welfare Act

Description: Protection of Indian children and families

Safe /Self Sufficient: I am fully knowledgeable of the Indian Child Welfare Act and how it protects Indian children and families

Stable: I have some knowledge about the Indian Child Welfare Act and have utilized relevant services available to me

At Risk: I have little knowledge of the Indian Child Welfare Act or whether it applies to me

In Crisis: I have no knowledge of what the Indian Child Welfare Act is or how it relates to me

## Knowledge of Legal Rights

Description: Awareness of legal rights with child welfare / juvenile justice systems

Safe / Self Sufficient: I am knowledgeable of my legal rights and can advocate for myself

Stable: I am knowledgeable of my legal rights but need assistance

At Risk: I have some knowledge of my legal rights but do not know how to exercise them or where to ask for help

In Crisis: I have no knowledge of my legal rights

# Reunification Stages in Court Cases

Description:

Safe /Self Sufficient: Completed all requirements of case plan for reunification. Children are returned to parents.

Stable: Completed most of the case plan for reunification required by the court. On track for reunification.

At Risk: Partially completed case plans for reunification ordered by the court

In Crisis: Failing to complete services or case plan for reunification ordered by the court. In danger of losing children to permanency plan Matrix Outcomes Model, 2011
